## Notice to families

On June 25, our award-winning Child Assessment Unit (CAU) is closing for 10 weeks. This will let us make some important improvements to provide even better patient care. The CAU will be re-modeled and will re-open on September 7.

During the time we are closed, children ages 10-12 will be cared for at our Adolescent Assessment Unit (AAU), which is also at the Cambridge Hospital campus. The AAU has a great team of providers. We work closely with them to serve our patients and we have helped them adapt their care program to meet the needs of children this age. During the 10 week period that the CAU is closed, children ages 3 to 9 will be referred temporarily to similar units at other hospitals.

Please know that we are doing everything we can to make this easy for children and their families. If your child is still in our care on the CAU on June 25 and is 10 years of age or older, we will move them to our AAU for the rest of their treatment. If your child is still in our care on the CAU on June 25 and is under 10 years old, we will make arrangements to transfer them to another facility for the rest of their treatment should further treatment be necessary.
