Experiential Learning

- Learn how to run/lead a “Suboxone Group Visit”
- Attend and interview patients in the **Inpatient/Detox** Setting
- Attend an **Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)**
- Attend a **Methadone clinic**
- Attend an **Interdisciplinary Consultation Service around chronic pain and addiction**
- Teach clinical teams (medical assistants, nurses, front desk) about **how to respond to an overdose with naloxone**

Other opportunities based on resident interest?

- Advocacy around Substance Use Disorders
- Research: GBOT- group-based opioid treatment (GBOT), Emergency Room-initiated Buprenorphine, and developing a national addiction curriculum for FM Residents (talk to Randi)
