If you previously registered with CITI, go to the <u>CITI homepage</u> and login with your existing user name and password. If you have not previously registered with CITI please refer to the instruction sheet for new users. <u>NOTE</u>: The CHA IRB office does not have access to your existing user name and password. You will need to <u>contact CITI directly for this information</u>.

You must click the "Submit" button on each quiz page to receive a score and save it to the program. If you exit the quiz without doing so, you will have to take the quiz again; an incomplete status will appear in the completed module summary. You will not be able to advance to the next module until you have taken the quiz and saved it. The minimum passing score for a quiz is 80%.






When <u>all</u> modules are completed, on the "My Reports" page, under the heading "Completion Report" click "View" to print and download a copy of your completion report.
